## Portsoy Loop



**Huntly Square**  
(round trip)



**5km / 3miles**



**1.0 hour - walking**  
**20 minutes - cycling**

A 5km loop around Huntly using the Portsoy Road path. Mainly on tarmacked paths and pavements, with a section of hardpack dirt walkway beside a main road.

From **Huntly Town Square** head north up **Castle Street** and left at the War Memorial onto **West Park Street**. **1** Follow this road to the end **2** and take a left followed by an immediate right along a path, which starts off as a rough track but turns into a paved surface. Follow this until the end and enter the pavement at **Deveron Road**. **3** Turn right and keep right until reaching a bridge crossing the **River Deveron**. **4**

After crossing the bridge over the **River Deveron** **4** turn right onto the dirt walkway beside the **Portsoy road (B9022)** and continue along this for 1km until the walkway ends and take a right down the road signposted to the **Castle Hotel**. **5**

Go along this road for 1km until reaching the driveway to the **Castle Hotel**, take a right here **6** down past the Hotel onto the walkway to the **bridge crossing the River Deveron**. **7**

Follow the road around to the left, circling the ruins of **Huntly Castle** **8** on the left, and head up the tree-lined road past **The Gordon Schools**. Keep heading straight until returning to **Huntly Square**.
