Queen Mary's Bridge

+ 2km / 1.2miles 0.5 hour

A short, easy circular walk from Rothiemay following a mown grass path along the north bank of the Deveron to a historic bridge, reputedly built for a visit of Mary Queen of Scots to Rothiemay Castle. The route loops around the former castle's historic dovecot and returns along a stoned track back to the center of Rothiemay.

There is some parking on the main street of Rothiemay.

From the Rothiemay main street head **north and turn right** () down the track next to the old Castle Gatehouse. Follow this road for **300m** and make a right down a **grassy path**. (2)

Follow this grassy path round to the left and down to the end of the field. ③ Follow this path to the right and it should take you next to Queen Mary's Bridge by the River Deveron. ④

Take a right at the bridge and follow the track past a **fishing hut** and through a **stone gateway**. **(5)** Take a track leading up right before reaching the bridge **(6)** which will take you back to the main street.
